Heathcote Williams was a poet, magician, lyricist, artist, playwright and counter culture icon. His plays include *The Local Stigmatic*, *AC/DC*, *Hancock's Last Half-Hour* and *Killing Kit*.

Jack Moylett trained at The Drama Centre and was a founder member of Ken Campbell's Science Fiction Theatre of Liverpool. He moved to New York where he founded the Transatlantic Theatre Co. In one of the first presentations of the *The Immortalist* at Aunt Twackey's Parlour in Liverpool in 1977, he played the Interviewer to Neil Cunningham's *Immortalist*. He writes, directs and acts.

Alison Mullin is RADA trained. She worked with the Young Vic and the Glasgow Citizens Theatre before going to New York and working for the Transatlantic Theatre Co.
